Strategic Procurement Outlook

Professional Services Review (PSR) investigates suspected cases of inappropriate practice by health practitioners on request from Medicare Australia. The scheme gives the PSR authority to investigate whether health practitioners have engaged in inappropriate practice in providing Medicare services or when prescribing medication. Such investigations protect patients, the community and the Commonwealth from the risks and costs of health practitioners practicing inappropriately. 'Inappropriate practice' is practice that would be unacceptable to the general body of the profession. The PSR Scheme covers medical practitioners, dentists, optometrists, chiropractors, physiotherapists, podiatrists, osteopaths, nurse practitioners and midwives.

The procurement described in this forecast is expected to be sought in this financial year, based on the best information available at the time of publication.
