



PSR Determining Authority Appointment

The Professional Services Review Agency (PSR) is seeking applications for part-time statutory appointment positions to the Determining Authority.

PSR is looking to appoint members who are appropriately qualified, experienced, and willing to take part in considering and determining sanctions to apply to practitioners who have been found to have engaged in inappropriate practice under Part VAA of the Health Insurance Act 1973.

The members of the Determining Authority consist of:

- a **Chair**, who must be a medical practitioner,
- a **community representative** who must not be a health practitioner, but should have experience in decision-making in a health disciplinary context, and
- Another member who is from the same profession as the practitioner whose case the DA is reviewing. Other members must be one of the following: **Medical Practitioner, Optometrist, Chiropractor, Nurse, Midwife, Dental Practitioner**

To be eligible you must be an Australian citizen and currently engaged in clinical practice (if a practitioner applicant).

Roles are due to commence in May 2022 for a 2 year appointment

As part of the selection process, your name and application will be forwarded to the Australian Medical Association and/or relevant professional body that is responsible for providing the Minister with advice on your suitability to perform the role. If endorsed, your name and CV will be sent to the Minister for appointment.
